## **Embedding Videos from Learn360**

To embed a video from Learn360 into your learning platform:

- 1. Access the Learn360 website through the VLC Games and Databases tab
- 2. Use the Login information provided on the VLC Teacher Master Password List to log in to Learn360 when prompted do so. This list can be obtained from your Learning Commons Informationist (LCI). Learn360 login information is school-specific. Ensure that you type in the General Username exactly as it appears, including the -user following the numbers. You may create a personal account once you have logged in to the general one.
- 3. Choose a video or other shareable media. Here is an example. You will note here that you can access the full video or just a specific segment.

4. Click on Share <\$ to get the following drop-down window and select Embed Link

- 5. To simply share the link to the video, copy and paste the Record URL into your learning platform. If you copy and paste the LTI Link, you will be directed to the Learn360 login page not the video. Students should not have access to the Learn360 password. This is the method that you will have to use when providing links to videos in PowerPoint and Teams/OneNote platforms since they do not accept embed codes from Learn360.
- 6. To embed the video into a learning platform, you will need to copy and paste the Embed code by highlighting the entire code in the Embed Code box. Choose the Embed Video size **before** highlighting the code information since this is part of the coding.
- 7. Paste this code into the appropriate location in your platform. For example, in D2L you must either edit an existing HTML file or create a file. Embed code can be entered in the "Insert Stuff" page of your D2L file.

- 8. NOTE: Depending on the version of PowerPoint you are using, you may not be able to embed Learn360 videos into you slide show. You may also be limited to YouTube videos when inserting URL addresses into the Online video option. Currently, Learn360 is not supported by the version of PowerPoint provided by the UCDSB Microsoft Office365 Suite.
- 9. Learn360 videos are free from advertisements and can be uploaded to both public and private learning platforms.
